Shane Foster, originally from Lancashire England, commenced his brass playing career at a young age joining his local colliery band on cornet, then moving to the Soprano when he was twelve.

By the age of sixteen, Shane held the highly coveted Soprano cornet seat at the famous champion band CWS Manchester, under the musical direction of the renowned conductor and radio presenter Frank Renton.

Over the next twenty five years, Shane played Soprano for some of the UK's most successful conductors, at various Championship bands in the Yorkshire and Lancashire areas. These included Grimethorpe Colliery, Yorkshire Imps and Brighouse & Rastrick. Also local Lancashire band Wingates, and notably, Leyland Vehicles Band, gaining invaluable experience under the directorship of the dynamic and charismatic conductor and band tutor, Richard Evans,



In the year 2000, Shane retired as a Soprano soloist to concentrate on his conducting career, working extensively with brass bands in the Lancashire and Yorkshire areas, gaining excellent results at both regional and National contest level.

In 2004, Shane was appointed MD of the Yorkshire Electric Driglington Band. This became a very successful partnership, culminating in taking the band through from contesting in the First section, to qualifying to compete in the Championship section Yorkshire area in under Three years.

In 2006 Shane emigrated to New Zealand with his family. Since that time he has conducted and trained bands nationally in New Zealand and Australia, including A grade bands Canterbury Brass and Woolston from Christchurch, and the Alpine Energy Timaru Band, on a freelance and resident MD basis. In recent years Shane has adjudicated at the New Zealand Brass Band National contest and various provincial contests around the country.

Shane is a member of the National Association of Brass Band Conductors and the National Association of Brass Band Adjudicators UK.
