A VERY WARM WELCOME to everybody in Church today as we meet together to worship God the Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; our Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier.

ALTHOUGH today is Anzac Day, the readings are still those proper to a Sunday in Eastertide since the latter is a Privileged Season like Advent and Lent. However, at the Solemn Eucharist the hymns have been chosen with Anzac Day in mind, and those from this parish who fell in the two World Wars will be remembered in the Prayers of the People.

JUST to confuse you, the lectionary from which the three readings at the Solemn Eucharist are taken uses *Sundays in Eastertide* (which includes Easter Sunday) as opposed to the traditional Anglican usage of *Sundays after Easter* (which doesn't) hence the difference in the numbering.
