New Dean for Christchurch Bishop Victoria Matthews has announced that the Revd Lynda Patterson, at present acting Dean, is to be the Dean of the transitional Cathedral, with the Revd Nick Mountfort, at present Vicar of Highfield in Timaru, to be the associate Dean.

David Cappel Rice to return to America The former Dean of Dunedin, and for the past five and a half years Bishop of Waiapu, has announced that he will return to the United States to become the provisional Bishop of San Joaquin in eastern California. vears ago the Bishop of San Joaquin lead his diocese to break away from the Episcopal Church because of its departure from orthodoxy, taking all its churches and trusts with it to form the Anglican Church in San Joaquin. While the remnant Episcopal Church has regained a few properties through the courts, it remains a rump core of a few congregations, and it is this attentuated reality that David Cappel Rice will lead from February next year. The Episcopal Church is also trying to regroup in a similar manner in South Carolina, where Bishop Mark Lawrence lead his diocese into a new ecclesial mode of existence.
