### **Parish News**

<u>Potluck lunch</u> As is our custom on the second Sunday of the month a potluck lunch follows the 10.30 am Service. All welcome.

<u>BBQ at Nigel's</u> There will be a BBQ at Nigel Westbrook's 92 Hargest Crescent on Tuesday evening beginning at 5 pm. While this end of year social gathering is particularly

intended for the housegroup that began its life at Nigel's some months back it is open to all parishioners, who would be most welcome. Nigel's house is within the lee of the former St Peter the Less mission Church of this parish. Please bring a salad and/or something to drink.

Vestry news Last month's Vestry meeting decided to raise the functional replacement insurance valuation on the Church to \$1.7 million, and to reduce the cover on the Vicarage to \$580,000. This reflects the fact that in the event of a rebuild the parish would not wish to replicate the present large two storey dwelling, but would instead opt for a single story contemporary four bedroomed dwelling. The hall and contents insurance remain the same, though the pulpit, altar and reredos are separately listed and valued for full replacement at \$70,000. Our earthquake cover remains. It was noted that some of our regular hall users have faded away, and it was decided to advertise in such a way as to gain two new regular hall users. The sound system will be updated in February as the money collected for this purpose will be helpful as an operational reserve to carry the parish through the traditionally financially lean month of January.
