<u>Five Unusual Documentaries</u> Our season of documentaries continues tomorrow night 13 February with **Next Year in Jerusalem**. When then Dunedin based playwright Mike Riddell finally got his play "Jerusalem, Jerusalem" on stage he used a collection of mostly local actors to portray the last days of James K Baxter. The play was a smash hit in Dunedin, toured New Zealand, and then won critical acclaim at the Edinburgh

Festival and a rapturous reception in Northern Ireland and the Greenbelt Festival. This documentary chronicles how the play came together and the behind the scenes travails and triumphs of the production. Brian Kilkelly, one of the actors, will lead the Q and A afterwards This will be in the Vicarage at 7 pm..

Archbishop David Moxon dates confirmed Archbishop David Moxon retires from his job as ambassador for the Anglican Communion at the Anglican centre in Rome in June. He will preside and preach here at St Peter's on Sunday 26 November, the feast of Christ the King. Two days later he will give the last of the Caversham lectures for 2017 on the current state of Anglican Roman Catholic relations.
