Christchurch reflections Last weekend I attended the 150th anniversary celebrations of St Mary's Addington, Christchurch where I was Vicar for nine years from the mid 80's to the mid 90's. In many ways this was the most satisfying and achieving of my ministries yet what a difference the wheels of time had made for I recognised only about a dozen people and was a stranger to many who were there. I was asked to be the MC at the Saturday night dinner but wondered if the job could have been better done by one of the guests Jim Hopkins, well known wit, raconteur and after dinner speaker, who had grown up in the Addington Vicarage in the 1950's. My immediate predecessor Fr Peter Williams preached a wonderful sermon at the Sunday Eucharist as he spoke of the way Henry Sewell who gifted the land for the building of the Church had a desire for there to be an Anglican Church at the heart of every community in the new colony. I stayed in the Deanery and was delighted to find a Sunday Evensong congregation of 130, quite a contrast to the normal half a dozen at best at Dunedin Cathedral Evensongs.
