### **2017 St Peter's Organ recital**

The third of our annual organ recitals will take place on Saturday 15 July at 1.00 pm when we host John Linker, organist and music director of the Christchurch Transitional Cathedral. The programme will begin with J.S. Bach's *Prelude and Fugue A-moll*, BWV 543 and then his *O Mensch, bewein dein Sunde gross* from the *Little Organ Book*. Two 19<sup>th</sup> century pieces then follow, Felix Mendelssohn's *Sonata 3, Opus 65, Number 3* and Robert Schumann's *Fugue 1 on B-A-C-H*. The second half of the programme is taken up with 20<sup>th</sup> century works Jan Nieland's *Prelude, Choral and Variations*, Dan Locklair's *The Peace may be exchanged* (from the Rubrics of the American Episcopal Prayer Book), Leo Sowerby's *Carillion* and two movements from Louis Vierne's *Organ Symphony number 3*. The programme thus includes German, Dutch, French and American composers for the organ.
