2017 St Peter's Organ recital

The third of our annual organ recitals will take place on **Saturday 15 July at 1.00 pm** when we host **John Linker**, organist and music director of the **Christchurch Transitional Cathedral**. The programme will begin with J.S. Bach's *Prelude and Fugue A-moll*, BWV 543 and then his *O Mensch, bewein dein Sunde gross* from the *Little Organ Book*. Two 19th century pieces then follow, Felix Mendelssohn's *Sonata 3, Opus 65, Number 3* and Robert Schumann's *Fugue 1 on B-A-C-H*. The second half of the programme is taken up with 20th century works Jan Nieland's *Prelude, Choral and Variations*, Dan Locklair's *The Peace may be exchanged* (from the Rubrics of the American Episcopal Prayer Book), Leo Sowerby's *Carillion* and two movements from Louis Vierne's *Organ Symphony number 3*. The programme thus includes German, Dutch, French and American composers for the organ.
