Fourth film The final film of our Summer film season *Seek and Devour* will be screened in the Vicarage on Wednesday evening at 7.30 pm. A documentary about Los Angeles food critic Jonathan Gold whose endless search for new food experiences focuses on little known and undiscovered ethnic restaurants and food trucks while eschewing famous top of the line restaurants. Insights are offered into one of the most ethnically and culinary diverse cities of the world but also shows Gold's power to make or break culinary reputations.
