General Synod news After lengthy consideration Motion 29 authorising same sex blessings in dioceses where the bishop authorises such has passed. Tikanga Pasifika made it clear that it does not want same sex blessings and will not authorise such

within their jurisdiction as they would be contrary to the law in their three countries and would be repugnant to the cultural values of their Island nations. However they also stated that they would not exercise their power of veto on the legislation and would allow it to pass if that was what the other two Tikanga wanted. Two Synod members, the Revds Jay Behan and Al Drye from the Christchurch diocese, immediately resigned as members of General Synod. An air of uncertainty hangs over the outcome as to how many will leave the Anglican Church and whether the GAFCON Primates will step in with a cross border Provincial intervention and ordain a missionary Bishop to lead and pastorally care for the departees in a new alternative Anglican structure. A proposal to scrap Confirmation was rejected by the Synod though a rite of reception into the Anglican Church was approved. A further step towards mutual recognition of the Methodist and Anglican orders was taken.
