Meeting God in the Gospel of Mark

The late Metropolitan Anthony Bloom, when a sceptical young man, attended an address by an eminent theologian while at a youth camp. He was not impressed and went home to confirm his impression of Christianity as empty and stupid. He read the Gospel of Mark as it was the shortest.

"The feeling I had occurs sometimes when you are walking the street and suddenly you turn around because you feel someone is looking at you. While I was reading, before I reached the beginning of the third chapter, I suddenly became aware that on the other side of my desk there was a Presence. I realised immediately: if Christ is standing there alive, that means he is the risen Christ."
