New to the parish If you have recently joined one of our congregations please consider joining our envelope/planned giving scheme. Please speak to the Wardens or the Vicar if you would like to join.

Some wise words from our envelope recorder. Each year when it comes to ordering the envelopes for giving I check to see how many are required. You may not have the same envelope number you had the year before as this is not always possible. Each box of envelopes costs \$100 per box of 10 sets. It is a waste to order envelopes we do not need, hence the change of your previous envelope number. Please destroy your old envelopes as using them makes more work for me to track back to see who the envelope belonged to. Let me reassure you that I am the only person who knows the amount of offering received. I also issue tax receipts for the envelopes and direct debits each year. Extra-Provincial diocese under way The parishes, clergy and people who disaffiliated from the New Zealand Anglican church over the same sex blessings issue have met in a Synod and have constituted themselves as an extra-provincial diocese, have adopted a constitution and canons, and have elected a Bishop-elect, the Revd Jay Behan, the Vicar of St Stephen's Shirley. They have 12 parishes, mostly in Christchurch, but also in Hamilton and Dunedin. Some are large, Shirley and former St John's Latimer Square are in the hundreds, while some of the new start-ups like the one in Hornby are around 80. The challenge for the new "biblically orthodox" expression of Anglicanism is whether they can plant new congregations across the country and so avoid being a rump core conservative evangelical group located mostly in Christchurch who might well die out within a generation. One factor that may assist them are potential developments within their parent denomination. Every denomination that has opted for same sex blessings has pressed on within a few years to permitting church gay weddings. If that were to happen further defections would be inevitable and some would find a new home in the GAFCON affiliated extra-provincial diocese.
