<u>A funeral close to home</u> Fr Hugh was in Christchurch Monday through Wednesday to take the funeral Service for his uncle and Godfather Nigel Bowron, the last of the three brothers of his father.

What can be found in a drain For several decades the internal church wall near the Link has been bubbling away with efflorescence caused by water infiltration from a mysterious source. Recently it was noticed that the downpipe in this area was leaking and was probably too small to handle the volume of water. It was replaced with a larger one but the plumber found that it was not connected to a drain but just poured directly into often already water logged soil. Digging down an old ceramic pipe drain was found leading into the one by the sacristy. Once the down pipe was connected to the drain it was flushed out with a high pressure jetter unit. Afterwards an old drink can and wine bottle was pulled out from the storm water drain. The drain was very clogged up with dirt and roots but is now clear. If this is indeed the cause of the water infiltration into the wall it will take several years for the wall to dry out. Afterwards it could be sanded and painted never to bubble up again.
