<u>Pray for those whose memorial occurs at this time</u> Lawrence McCovern, Roger Dale, Ivy Dale, Geoffrey Hughes (Priest), and David MacGrill. <u>Cathedral news</u> Now that the intertwined issues of accommodation and visas have been resolved the next Dean of Dunedin and his family are expected to arrive in Dunedin January/February. The Revd Tony Curtis is expected to be instituted to the Cathedral at a convenient date within that period. The issue of finding a new organist and music director remains unresolved. The Cathedral's finances are insufficient to make such a full time appointment. Attendances at the Cathedral's main Sunday Services remain modest except for special event Services.

<u>A tale of two Cathedrals</u> The conservation lobby has admitted defeat in its attempts to halt the deconstruction of the Christchurch Catholic Cathedral on its Barbadoes St site as there are no legal remedies available. Construction of the new Cathedral and diocesan offices will soon begin on the Oxford Terrace site just three blocks away from its Anglican counterpart. This Catholic Cathedral will be up well before the Anglican one reopens as renovation and repair work on it will probably continue until the end of the decade, and perhaps beyond. Meanwhile the Transitional Cathedral will soon find itself hemmed in by the new covered stadium next door which should be underway soon.

<u>**Time to make your confession**</u> Advent has begun, a penitential season in which it is entirely appropriate to make your confession before Christmas. These are usually made in Church at a time arranged with the clergy. For further information see "Reconciliation of a Penitent" on page 750 of the New Zealand Prayer book.
