# From the Vicar.

I discovered that the colour, in the liturgical tradition, for today can be either white or red. White for the end of the Easter season or red for preparation for Pentecost. As in nature's seasons, beginnings and endings can overlay and interconnect. There was a lot of discussion about changes, seasons, loss and gain during the Ministry School I attended this week. The biggest issue is how we support each other through the inevitable changes and what we make of them.

The disciples didn't know what to expect when Jesus assured them that he would send the Advocate and Guide, the Holy Spirit. What they did know was that Jesus had been true to his promise and that he had risen from the dead and still loved and cared for them. He had been seen and had shared meals and taught them about the Kingdom of God. A Kingdom they had only glimpsed in the miracles, and completely unlike anything they had experienced at the hands of Caesar and Herod. I decided red would be our colour for today, so that we too can contemplate what the Holy Spirit will do in our lives. Natalie
