The recognition of the transfiguration of Jesus Christ is an incredibly important aspect of the Christian faith. In some ways, more important than Christmas. This event is a tangible example that Jesus of Nazareth is both human and divine. The disciples were witness to the fact that the two patriarchs Moses and Elijah, left the heavenly realms to talk with Jesus. However, this event in time also resulted in God speaking directly to the disciples. This event transcends time, space and all other human experiences of God, in its inclusivity and clarity. This event proves that there is life after death. This event proves the resurrection of the body and that we will recognise others after death. This event proves that God can speak to us, both through others and personally but ultimately this event proves that Jesus is the Son of God, Creator of all things.
