This week has required a lot of listening and gracious love. It has been said that to be unable to listen is to be unable to give as well. It is easy to know what is good for someone else. It is difficult to listen and let them define themselves. St. Benedict puts this idea neatly into one sentence when, he says, "Anticipate one another with honor, most patiently enduring one another's infirmities, whether of body or character; strive in paying obedience to one another, offer love modestly, fear God in love and love one another" It takes a lot of listening to hear the needs of those around us before they even speak them. But there is no good human community without it. Listening and love are parts of the same whole. As children of God, I pray we serve each other by listening, not being tempted to provide an answer but to hear what the person needs to share.
